With Acrobat 5.0 on your desktop, you can:

- Protect corporate brand elements: Turn any document into an Adobe PDF file that anyone using Acrobat Reader can view.

- Deliver confidential information more securely: With password protection and 128-bit encryption, Acrobat helps you protect sensitive content from unauthorized access and alteration.
