Connecting to a Computer

- 1. Ensure the projector and your computer are turned off.
- Connect one end of the VGA cable to the "VGA In" connector on the projector; connect the other end to the VGA connector on the computer and tighten the screws.
- Connect one end of the power cord into the AC power socket on the projector; connect the other end to an electrical outlet.

Powering On the Projector

- 1. Remove the lens cap.
- 2. Turn on the projector first and then the computer.
- 3. Adjust the position, focus and zoom.
- 4. Run you presentation.

Powering Off the Projector

- 1. Press the power button twice.
- Do not remote AC power cord from outlet until the projector fan shut down.
